6. Acceptance of Applicants. All applicants are approved per Ozim's recommendation.
Memberships are accepted by affirming the 7 Traits of the CommonWealth and being of the namuli/ant colony mind and heart.
7. The facilities of the Ant Hill Communities.
The property directly adjoining the media operations of the midrash, aka ALephBet Document Centre, has been acquired for the beginning of the Communities. This property and the property of the media production facility were owned by the same household in past history. The property was divided into three parcels. The property of the AHC became available on August 15, 2008. The property was purchased by funds from BayitHhaSham Midrash and a loan secured by Shmual Bann Aharuwan. It is anticipated that the loan will be repaid within ten years. The property was occupied by a family of five. There are 4 bedrooms, kitchen, two baths, living room area, full basement, breezeway, two car garage, out building 16'x32'. The property is entitled in the name of Ant Hill Communities. All who reside there will have a title of counselor to commence the settlement.
8. The estimated cost per resident is 600.00 monthly. A final budget of the communities will be undertaken by the community members as they gather and take up residence. In that there are numerous preparations before residence, Nov 1, 2008, is a target date for the first residents to move into the facility.
9. The objectives of the communities have been set forth in prior documents. The move into these objectives will be determined by the nucleus of the communities and their advisors.
10. Ayil has found an ideal place of 212 acres for the communities and its implementation of objectives. Ayil's update on a forthcoming proposal.
